

The Impossible Space: Lumbar Punctures

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✓ Rapid Procedure Review

- 1. Position the patient in either the seated or lateral recumbent position.
- 2. Assess landmarks for ideal point of entry.
- 3. Open lumbar puncture kit, ensure all necessary equipment is present, and set up collection tubes in numerical order.
- 4. Sterile preparation of the L3/L4 and L4/L5 Interspaces.
- 5. Anesthetize the intended procedure entry point, starting with the skin and then deeper into the tissue in order to form a tract for the spinal needle.
- **6.** Assure patient is comfortable and still in optimal positioning for the procedure.
- 7. Inset spinal needle with bevel parallel to the spine.
- 8. Once the needle has entered the dural space, remove the stylet, and an opening pressure may be performed if the patient is in the lateral recumbent position.
- 9. Collect 1-2cc of fluid in each collecting tube.
- 10. Replace style and remove spinal needle.
- **11.** Place bandage over procedure sight
- 12. Reposition the patient supine.



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
